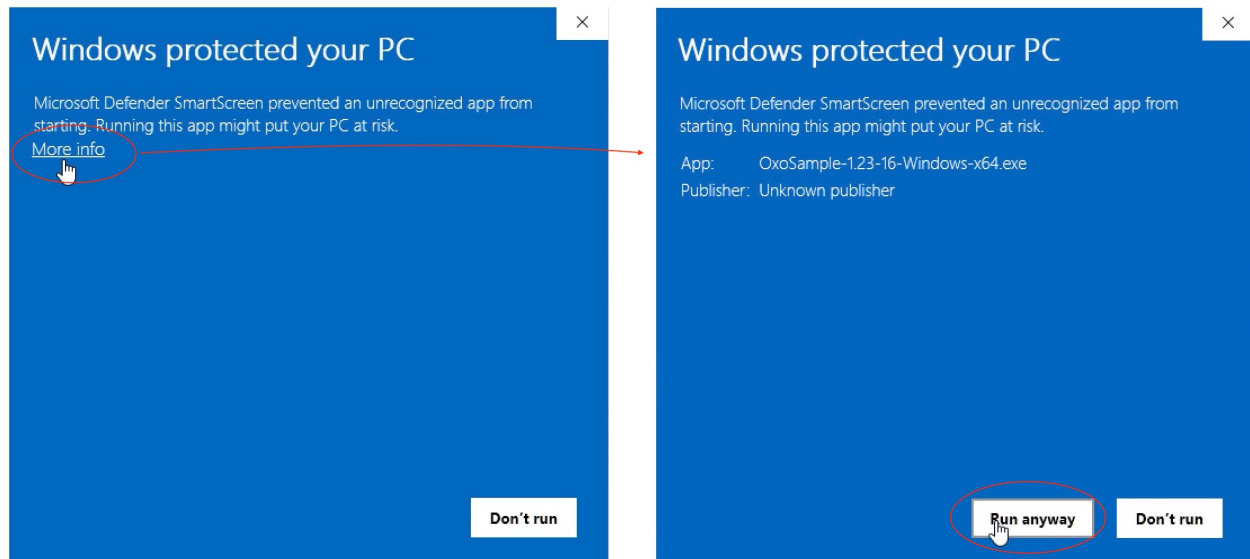


Installing Oxo Sample on Windows

Oxo Sample for Windows is not yet code-signed, so Microsoft Defender SmartScreen shows a blue "Windows protected your PC" screen the first time you run the installer.

This is not a virus warning: it only means the file has no publisher certificate Microsoft recognises. If you downloaded the installer from <https://oxo-music.com/>, it is safe to continue. You can also check the file with your own antivirus.

Click More info, then Run anyway (see below), and the installer opens normally.



Manual install (advanced users):

If you prefer not to run the installer, copy the OxoSample.vst3 folder into C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3\. Copying files will not show the SmartScreen screen. Use one method or the other, not both: two copies of the plug-in in different folders can confuse your DAW.
